

## Park System Donations

Walworth County welcomes donations for the acquisition, development and maintenance of its park system. There are two methods of donations -- restricted and unrestricted. Restricted donations are for those who wish to identify a specific purpose for the donation, or make the donation contingent upon a certain action by the county. Unrestricted donations are those that do not impose any conditions for use of the donated funds. An unrestricted donation in the amount of \$5,000 or less can be authorized and accepted by Shane Crawford, Director of Public Works.

Restricted donations, regardless of the value, and all unrestricted donations over \$5,000 must be recommended by the Walworth County Finance Committee and adopted by the full County Board of Supervisors as a resolution. The County Deputy Administrator-Finance assesses values of non-cash donations (i.e. land).

Contributions to Walworth County for public purposes are allowable as itemized income tax deductions in accordance with established IRS regulations. Donations will be receipted by the Public Works Department for cash donations of \$5,000 and less, and by the Finance Department for cash donations over \$5,000, and for all non-cash donations.
