**Resolution No. 05-04/20**

**Urging the State Legislature and Governor to Amend the Wisconsin Statewide Standing Order for the Dispensing of Naloxone**

1 Moved/Sponsored by: Health and Human Services Board

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3 **WHEREAS**, Walworth County has been identified as an area of concern for high rates of opioid  
4 overdose by the Wisconsin Department of Health Services; and,

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6 **WHEREAS**, opioids are a class of drugs, which act directly on the nervous system which can  
7 depress the central nervous system and respiratory system which can result in death; and,

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9 **WHEREAS**, naloxone is an opioid antagonist which counteracts the life-threatening depression  
10 of the central nervous system and respiratory system and has been proven to save lives; and,

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12 **WHEREAS**, on October 26, 2017, the Department of Health and Human Services declared that  
13 the opioid crisis affecting our Nations a public health emergency; and,

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15 **WHEREAS**, Walworth County Division of Public Health is required to respond to public health  
16 emergencies; and,

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18 **WHEREAS**, Wisconsin local Public Health Departments are required to respond to the leading  
19 causes of premature death within their jurisdictions per Wisconsin Administrative Rule  
20 140.02(c); and,

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22 **WHEREAS**, local Public Health Departments are uniquely positioned to implement community  
23 level interventions; and,

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25 **WHEREAS**, Public Health nurses make up a significant portion of the staff of local health  
26 departments; and,

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28 **WHEREAS**, Registered Nurses in Wisconsin may only perform delegated acts for which there  
29 is a written protocol when in a professional capacity; and,

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31 **WHEREAS**, Wisconsin Statute 441.18 addresses only opioid antagonist administration,  
32 delivery, and dispensing by an advanced practice nurse; and,

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34 **WHEREAS**, Wisconsin Department of Health Services Chief Medical Officer Jonathan  
35 Meiman, MD issued a standing order allowing all Pharmacists to dispense naloxone; and,


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37 **WHEREAS**, the Walworth County Health and Human Services Board supports the State  
38 Legislature and Governor amending the Wisconsin Statewide Standing Order for the dispensing

1 of naloxone to explicitly include local Public Health Departments, as established by Wisconsin  
2 Chapter 251, be authorized to dispense and administer naloxone for the purpose of responding to  
3 the declared national public health emergency and opioid overdose.

5 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Walworth County Board of Supervisors  
6 urges the State Legislature and Governor to amend the Wisconsin Statewide Standing Order for  
7 the dispensing of naloxone to explicitly include local Public Health Departments, as established  
8 by Wisconsin Chapter 251, be authorized to dispense and administer naloxone for the purpose of  
9 responding to the declared national public health emergency and opioid overdose.

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11 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Walworth County Clerk is hereby directed to send a  
12 copy of this resolution to the Governor of Wisconsin, State legislators representing Walworth  
13 County, and the Wisconsin Counties Association.




