### THIS WEEK AT LAKELAND.

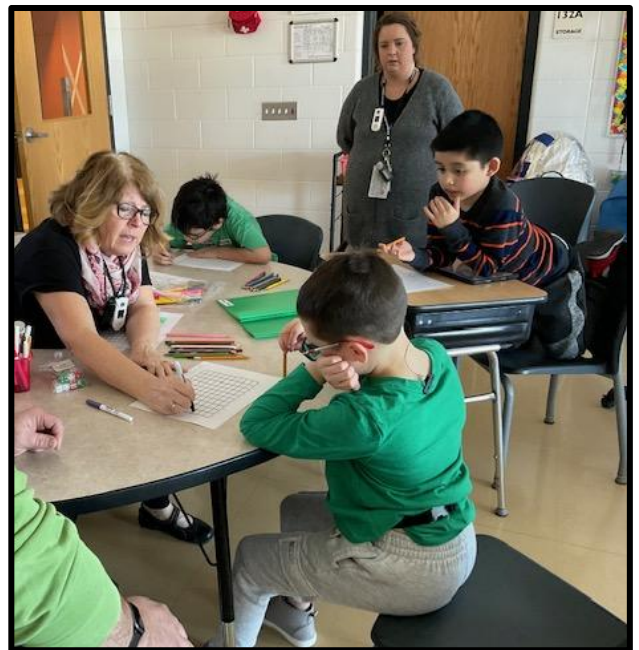
This week students celebrated Pi Day across the school with different activities in math class,

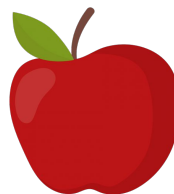
