

## The ADRC can help you:

- ◆ Provide education and options counseling related to long-term care

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The primary purpose of the ADRC Specialist is to provide the customer with unbiased information about services that will meet their needs. This includes sharing information with customers about agencies that provide needed services. The ADRC may operate programs that provide direct services to customers. The ADRC Specialist:

- Cannot attempt to influence customers for financial gain or other self-interests.
- Cannot attempt to influence customers in the interest of any service or program provider, including the ADRC itself.

The ADRC is prohibited from using revenue generated from direct service programs to support the ADRC Specialist program.

- Adults over the age of 60
- Adults 18-59 with physical and/or intellectual/developmental disabilities
- Children (age 17 1/2) with disabilities as they transition into the adult services system
- Adults with mental health or substance abuse concerns
- Caregivers

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## Services We Offer

### Information and Assistance

Provide knowledge about services, programs, resources and/or solutions for individuals with disabilities and/or older adults.

### Long-Term Care Options Counseling

Offer information about choices that are available to meet the long-term needs of individuals with disabilities and/or older adults.

## Services We Offer

### Benefits Counseling

Provide accurate and current information about private and government benefits and programs for individuals with disabilities and/or older adults.

### Adult Protective Services & Elder Abuse

Provide protection and advocacy for elderly or at-risk adults. Identify need for services and facilitate access to services.

### Long-Term Care Enrollment

Determine functional and financial eligibility for various long-term care funded programs. Provide enrollment counseling and assist with application.

### Home Delivered Meals

Provide a hot nutritious meal to individuals over 60 that are home-bound. Monday - Friday.

### Senior Dining Centers

Provide a nutritionally balanced hot meal and a place to socialize with others who are over the age of 60.

### Dementia Care Specialist

Offer support to individuals with dementia and their family caregivers through individualized care planning and community based programs, services and resources.

## Services We Offer

### Health Promotion And Prevention Programs

Provide wellness and prevention programs to help promote health and independence.

### In-home Support & Personal Care

Connect you to services that provide assistance to help you remain in your home. Services range from household chores to skilled nursing care.

### Transitional Services

Provide assistance to youth with disabilities transitioning from school to adulthood. Discuss options and connect to available benefits and services.

### Respite Care

Provide short-term relief for primary caregivers to assist with care, chores, etc. Connect with funding sources to possibly pay for services.

### Transportation

Assist with accessing safe, reliable and punctual transportation to non-emergent medical appointments, senior dining centers, employment or trips for socialization. Currently provided through VIP Services.
