Our Mission

To provide the people of Walworth County nutritional supplemental food, diapers, feminine hygiene and incontinence supplies during a time of crisis, in a cheerful, welcoming, nonjudgmental environment without regard to age, race, creed, color, national origin, physical or developmental disability, or sexual orientation.

HOW IT WORKS

The Food and Diaper Bank is open to the public twice a week, guests are welcome to come to pickup food and diapers once each month. Milk, food and supplies are always available in emergency situations. There is no charge for anything we provide.

We are open Fridays 1-4 pm and Saturdays 9 - 11 am. The office is manned all week as we receive food and restock.

WHAT WE PROVIDE

Since the pandemic, we have been forced to pre bag all of our groceries and serve thru a drive thru format. This keeps everyone safe while continuing to provide approximately 2 weeks worth of groceries. Each family receives frozen meats, fresh produce, dairy, dry goods, canned goods and breads.

DIAPERS, FEMININE HYGIENE AND INCONTINENCE PRODUCTS

These products are provided each month and brands vary. Many brands of baby formula and foods are also often available.

CLOTHING

We do not directly offer clothing on a regular basis but we do provide referral slips to The Clothing Outreach Center for anyone who is in need.

WHAT TO BRING TO THE FOOD BANK

- Photo ID
- Legal Piece of Mail to verify residence and others in household

TO RECEIVE DIAPERS

Qualifications are the same as for food and families must be able to verify the child lives in their home full time.

WHY ARE THERE INCOME GUIDELINES?

Some of our food comes from USDA programs. The rest is purchased and privately funded.

TEFAP is a federal program that provides food commodities to distribution sites like the food pantry. The food received represents only a portion of the total food we distribute. This food is purchased by the USDA to help our farmers maintain their prices. These guidelines are set by the USDA.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

Walworth County households are eligible to receive commodities at participating food pantries if the total gross income for the household does not exceed 300% of the federal poverty level. Eligibility is based on current income status and self-declared eligibility for participation.

If your income or financial situation has recently or suddenly changed, we are here to help you thru a difficult time. In those situations, these guidelines may not necessarily apply.

Senior Stock Box and Senior Assistance Mission (S.A.M.)

Senior StockBox is a free box of healthy foods that includes cereal, milk, canned veggies and fruits, pasta or rice, protein, fruit juice, canned meats and 2 lbs of fresh Wisconsin cheese. This box is offered in addition to the regular amount of food distributed by the pantry each month. **S.A.M.** is an additional program developed and funded by our team to include basic toiletries each month.

The Walworth County Food & Diaper Bank is the only distribution point for these two programs in Walworth County.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

People age 60+ who live in Walworth County and have a monthly income of \$1,354 or less (or \$1,832 for a two-person household). If your income and financial status has recently changed these guidelines may not necessarily apply.
