

**COMMITTEE MEMBER
NEEDED**

The Walworth County Board of Supervisors will be appointing one (1) alternate member to serve on the Walworth County Board of Adjustment (BOA). The BOA reviews and decides on requests for variances to the County's Zoning Ordinances. BOA members are appointed by the Walworth County Board of Supervisors, typically for a three-year term. The BOA meets the second Wednesday of each month at 9:00 a.m. to conduct hearings and on-site inspections, and the following day on Thursday at 9:00 a.m. to render decisions. BOA members receive a \$50.00 per diem for each meeting, and a county vehicle is available for the on-site inspections. Membership is open to all residents of UNINCORPORATED Walworth County, except for the Towns of LaGrange, Linn, Richmond and Delavan which are currently represented on the BOA. Applicants with public service experience, familiarity with local codes and ordinances, knowledge of real estate and the building trades are encouraged to apply. The county requires a "Notice of Interest" form to be submitted by applicants. The form is available online on the county's website at www.co.walworth.wi.us on the Land Use & Resource Management/Board of Adjustment web page at the "Citizen Representative Application" link or by request from the Land Use & Resource Management Department, P.O. Box 1001, Elkhorn, WI 53121 or the County Clerk's office, Room 101 in the Government Center, located at 100 W. Walworth St. in Elkhorn.
