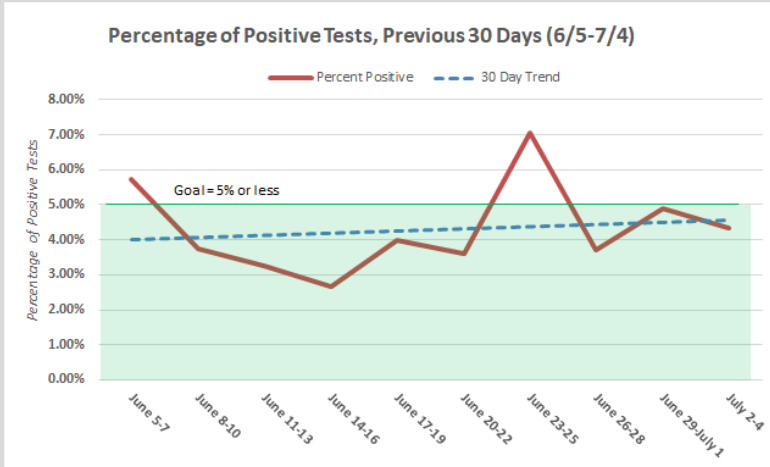


# Walworth County COVID-19

## Data Snapshot for July 9th, 2020



This graph shows the percentage of positive test results for each day between 6/5-7/4. The blue dashed line shows the average trend in the percent of positive cases within this time period.

The average percentage of positive tests over the last 14 days is 4.76%.

## Walworth County Key Indicators

Walworth County Public Health has released new phased guidance for operating safely during COVID-19. Key Indicators will guide when businesses and organizations should consider moving to the next phase.

Epidemiology	Over the past 14 days: Downward trend of the percentage of total tests that are positive <u>and</u> below an average of 5% of total tests are positive	<b>Green:</b> Below 5% positivity and downward trend <b>Yellow:</b> Only one of these metrics is met - less than 5% positivity or downward trend <b>Red:</b> Over 5% positivity and increasing trend	
Hospitals	Hospitals have the capacity in staffing and testing to manage COVID-19	<b>Green:</b> Hospitals have testing for all symptomatic clinical staff & have adequate staffing <b>Red:</b> Only one of these metrics is met - adequate testing or staffing	
	Hospitals have an adequate supply of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): face shields, goggles, N95 masks, surgical masks, and gowns	<b>Green:</b> 15+ day supply of all PPE <b>Yellow:</b> 7-14 day supply of all PPE <b>Red:</b> Less than 7 day supply of all PPE	
Public Health	All positive cases are contacted quickly to help reduce the spread of COVID-19	<b>Green:</b> 100% of new positive cases are contacted within 48 hours of receipt by Walworth County Public Health <b>Yellow:</b> 75% of new positive cases are contacted within 48 hours of receipt by Walworth County Public Health <b>Red:</b> 50% or less of new positive cases are contacted within 48 hours of receipt by Walworth County Public Health
