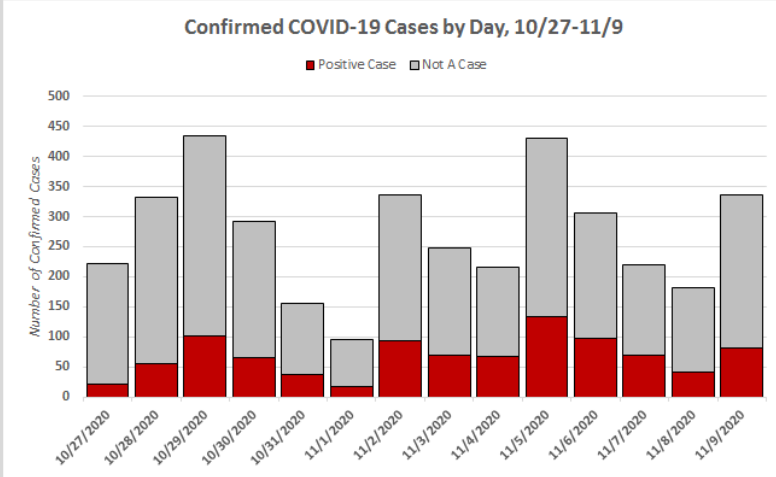


Walworth County COVID-19 Data Snapshot

November 12th, 2020



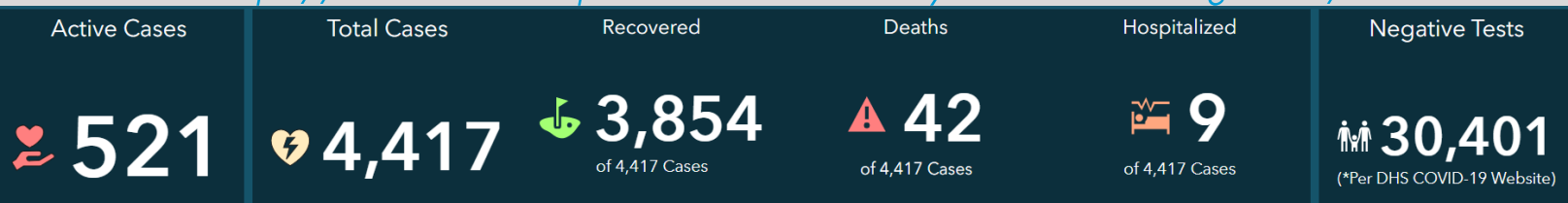
This graph shows the total number of positive and negative test results for each day between 10/27-11/9.

Walworth County Key Indicators

Walworth County Public Health has released new phased guidance for operating safely during COVID-19.

Key Indicators will guide when businesses and organizations should consider moving to the next phase.

Epidemiology	Over the past 14 days: Downward trend of the percentage of total tests that are positive <u>and</u> below an average of 5% of total tests are positive	<p>Green: Below 5% positivity and downward trend</p> <p>Yellow: Only one of these metrics is met - less than 5% positivity or downward/flat trend</p> <p>Red: Over 5% positivity and increasing trend</p>	
Hospitals	Over the past 14 days: hospital bed and ventilator capacity is not exceeded	<p>Green: >35% of ICU beds and >50% of ventilators are available</p> <p>Yellow: <35% of ICU beds or <50% of ventilators available</p> <p>Red: <35% of ICU beds and <50% of ventilators available</p>	
	Hospitals have an adequate supply of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): face shields, goggles, N95 masks, surgical masks, and gowns	<p>Green: 15+ day supply of all PPE</p> <p>Yellow: 7-14 day supply of all PPE</p> <p>Red: Less than 7 day supply of all PPE</p>	
Public Health	All positive cases are contacted quickly to help reduce the spread of COVID-19	<p>Green: 100% of new positive cases are contacted within 48 hours of receipt by Walworth County Public Health</p> <p>Yellow: 75% of new positive cases are contacted within 48 hours of receipt by Walworth County Public Health</p> <p>Red: 50% or less of new positive cases are contacted within 48 hours of receipt by Walworth County Public Health</p>
