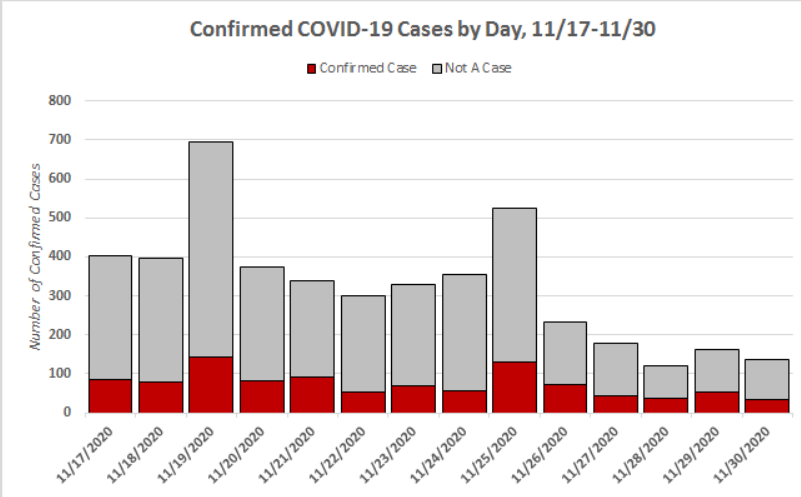


# Walworth County COVID-19 Data Snapshot

## Walworth County Key Indicators

Walworth County Public Health has released new phased guidance for operating safely during COVID-19.

Key Indicators will guide when businesses and organizations should consider moving to the next phase.

Epidemiology	Over the past 14 days: Downward trend of the percentage of total tests that are positive <u>and</u> below an average of 5% of total tests are positive	<p><b>Green:</b> Below 5% positivity and downward trend</p> <p><b>Yellow:</b> Only one of these metrics is met less than 5% positivity or downward/flat trend</p> <p><b>Red:</b> Over 5% positivity and increasing trend</p>	
Hospitals	Over the past 14 days: hospital bed and ventilator capacity is not exceeded	<p><b>Green:</b> &gt;35% of ICU beds and &gt;50% of ventilators are available</p> <p><b>Yellow:</b> &lt;35% of ICU beds or &lt;50% of ventilators available</p> <p><b>Red:</b> &lt;35% of ICU beds and &lt;50% of ventilators available</p>	
	Hospitals have an adequate supply of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): face shields, goggles, N95 masks, surgical masks, and gowns	<p><b>Green:</b> 15+ day supply of all PPE</p> <p><b>Yellow:</b> 7-14 day supply of all PPE</p> <p><b>Red:</b> Less than 7 day supply of all PPE</p>	
Public Health	Positive cases are contacted quickly to help reduce the spread of COVID-19	<p><b>Green:</b> &gt;75% of new confirmed cases have a phone call attempt made within 48 hours of receipt by Public Health</p> <p><b>Yellow:</b> 50-75% of new confirmed cases have a phone call attempt made within 48 hours of receipt by Public Health</p> <p><b>Red:</b> &lt;50% or less of new confirmed cases have a phone call attempt made within 48 hours of receipt by Public Health</p>
