<p>Over the past 14 days: hospital bed and ventilator capacity is not exceeded</p> <p>Hospitals have an adequate supply of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): face shields, goggles, N95 masks, surgical masks, and gowns</p>	<p><b>Green:</b> &gt;35% of ICU beds and &gt;50% of ventilators are available</p> <p><b>Yellow:</b> &lt;35% of ICU beds or &lt;50% of ventilators available</p> <p><b>Red:</b> &lt;35% of ICU beds and &lt;50% of ventilators available</p> <p><b>Green:</b> 15+ day supply of all PPE</p> <p><b>Yellow:</b> 7-14 day supply of all PPE</p> <p><b>Red:</b> Less than 7 day supply of all PPE</p>	 
<p>All positive cases are contacted quickly to help reduce the spread of COVID-19</p>	<p><b>Green:</b> &gt;75% of new confirmed cases have a phone call attempt made within 48 hours of receipt by Public Health</p> <p><b>Yellow:</b> 50-75% of new confirmed cases have a phone call attempt made within 48 hours of receipt by Public Health</p> <p><b>Red:</b> &lt;50% or less of new confirmed cases have a phone call attempt made within 48 hours of receipt by Public Health</p>
