## Featured County Positions

### Care / Trainer Mentor (Pandemic)

This position is responsible for training and education support at the unit level for all clinical team members, for acting as a liaison/mentor for new hire nursing staff (RN, LPN, CNA, CMA) and will develop and support a Certified Nursing Assistant program in the facility. This position works in collaboration with management, medical records, Information Technology, and other disciplines to streamline processes and systems within the Electronic Medical Record. This position also evaluates and revises the restorative education program to meet standards of practice and regulatory requirements.

- Associates degree in Nursing or Licensed Practical Nurse with five or more years experience in a long-term care setting may substitute for the RN or BSN designation..
- Six months to one year of relevant prior experience
- Wisconsin Registered Nurse or Licensed Practical Nurse license through WI Department of Safety and Professional Services.
- Monday through Friday with occasional weekends and hours vary based on needs (Full-Time)
