Resurfacing project to begin along WIS 67 in Walworth County

To invest in Wisconsin's transportation system, Governor Evers signed a \$1.95 million contract to improve WIS 67, between Salt Box Road and US 14 in the Village of Sharon, Walworth County. Work is scheduled to begin the week of August 2, 2021. Rock Road Inc., is the prime contractor for this project and will implement the following:

Project Improvements

- Pavement resurfacing
- Curb and gutter
- Update curb ramps to meet American's with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards
- Rehabilitation to the Piscasaw Creek bridge
- Resurfacing at the intersection of WIS 67 and Salt Box Road
- Signing, pavement marking, and erosion control

What to Expect

- During construction, WIS 67 will be closed to through traffic with a posted detour utilizing US 14, I-43 and WIS 140.
- Local access will be maintained for residents and businesses as well as emergency vehicles throughout construction.

Work is scheduled to begin the week of August 2 and be complete this fall.
