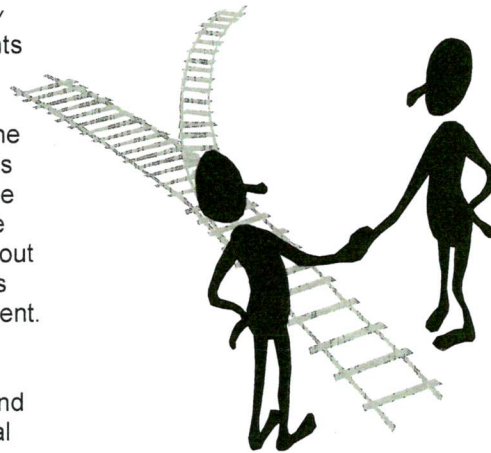


after Parenting Separation

THEN WHAT?

After this class, there are three options for those ordered to mediation:

1. File a custody/placement agreement on your own
2. Meet with the other parent and the mediator and develop an agreement to be written and filed by the mediator
3. After the first ordered mediation appointment, terminate mediation, pay the guardian ad litem (\$350 each downpayment, \$50/mo., balance due when final GAL bill submitted) and home study (\$800 total, \$400 each), go to court, and have the judge make the decisions for your family.
