A group of concerned people from the Elkhorn community came together in 2002—from area churches, the school system, county social services, service and civic groups—to discuss the needs of people in Elkhorn and what critical requests were not being met by any existing group or agency.

HOPE NOW, Inc. was formed to assist as many people as possible without duplicating efforts or enabling abuse of the community's charitable nature. Since its incorporation in 2004, HOPE NOW, Inc. has provided over \$600,000 in assistance to over a thousand Elkhorn area households to help meet emergency, short term needs. HOPE NOW, Inc. assists with:

- * Housing
- * Utilities
- * Vehicle repairs
- * Prescriptions
- * Holiday food baskets

HOPE NOW meets with applicants at the Elkhorn Youth Center, 420 E. Court St. Elkhorn, WI (across from the Walworth County Fairgrounds): at **6:30 pm on the 2nd and 4th Tues.** of every month.

Applications are reviewed during an interview and options for assistance and/or referrals to other agencies are discussed. After further review and verification of information provided to HOPE NOW, Inc., a decision is made whether to provide assistance at that time.

When assistance is provided, checks are written directly to landlords or service providers—not to the applicant.

Applicants must reside within the Elkhorn Area School District.

Assistance is only provided once in a twelve month period to a household.
